Itinerary and Included Sightseeing

Day 1: Arrive Buenos Aires

Hola Buenos Aires! This cosmopolitan city is filled with culture & diversity in everything from buildings to its people. As the birthplace of Tango there's a love of music, art, dance & football – not to mention world-renowned beef & red wine. Tonight, meet up with your Tour Manager & group, then maybe head to a local spot for dinner & a nightcap. Hotel

Day 2: Buenos Aires

Get out on 2 wheels for a half day bike tour of the important city spots like San Telmo & La Boca, before a coach tour to see more city highlights. Tonight, get ready to Tango like a local as you learn all the tricks at a dance lesson & show. Later, take it up a notch & experience BA by night. Hotel (B,D)

Day 3: Buenos Aires

With a free day you can experience BA your way. Visit Colonia in Uruguay or kayak the River Delta area of Tigre. In town you might catch a football game, maybe drink champagne at a polo match, hit the shops or pay a visit to the historic Gran Café Tortoni for a café con leche & a spot of people watching. Hotel (B)

Day 4: Buenos Aires to Iguassu Falls

Today we fly to Puerto Iguassu then travel to the Brazilian side to see the 275 individual waterfalls that make up Iguassu. You could take a heli-ride for a different angle on the falls, or try your luck at spotting Macaws & Toucans. Tonight, sample the delicious national drink, a caipirinha before a tasty Brazilian BBQ. Hotel (B,D)

Day 5: Iguassu Falls

We'll cross back into Argentina & visit their side of Iguassu Falls. Later, the day is all yours. Maybe try a speed boat ride to feel the spray of the Falls, take a zodiac boat ride to Saint Martin Island, go for a swim or take a short hike to the edge of the Devil's Throat. Hotel (B)

Day 6: Iguassu Falls to Buzios

Take it down a notch as we head to Buzios with its white sand & endless beaches for a couple of days of R&R. On our sailing trip, sit back with a caipirinha as we cruise to 2 beaches & 4 islands, while basking in the sun, snorkelling & taking in the coastline. Hotel (B)

Day 7: Buzios

You could rise early & watch the sunrise over the Atlantic Ocean. If you're up for it try surfing, or other activities like scuba diving. Or simply sit back with a book, explore the town or just work on your tan with a cocktail. Hotel (B)

Day 8: Buzios to Rio de Janeiro

Home to the world's largest Carnival celebration, Copacabana Beach & the Brazilian bikini, get ready for good times in Rio. This afternoon we'll visit the iconic Christ the Redeemer statue. Hotel (B)

Day 9: Rio de Janeiro

See the Lapa district & its 150 year-old aqueduct, the Arches of Lapa & Passeio Publico. Then we head to the summit of Sugarloaf Mountain. Hotel (B,D)

- Cable car ride up Sugarloaf Mountain

Day 10: Depart Rio de Janeiro

Our adventure ends after breakfast, when it's time to say 'Tchau' (goodbye) to your travel mates. (B)

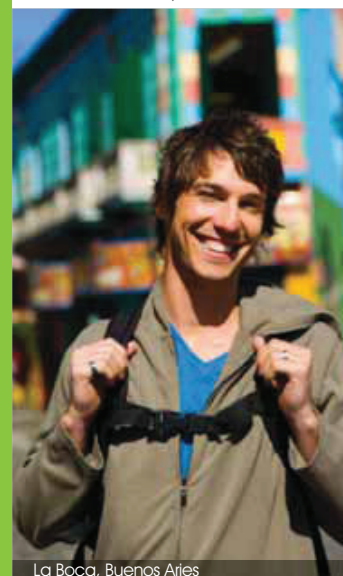
